

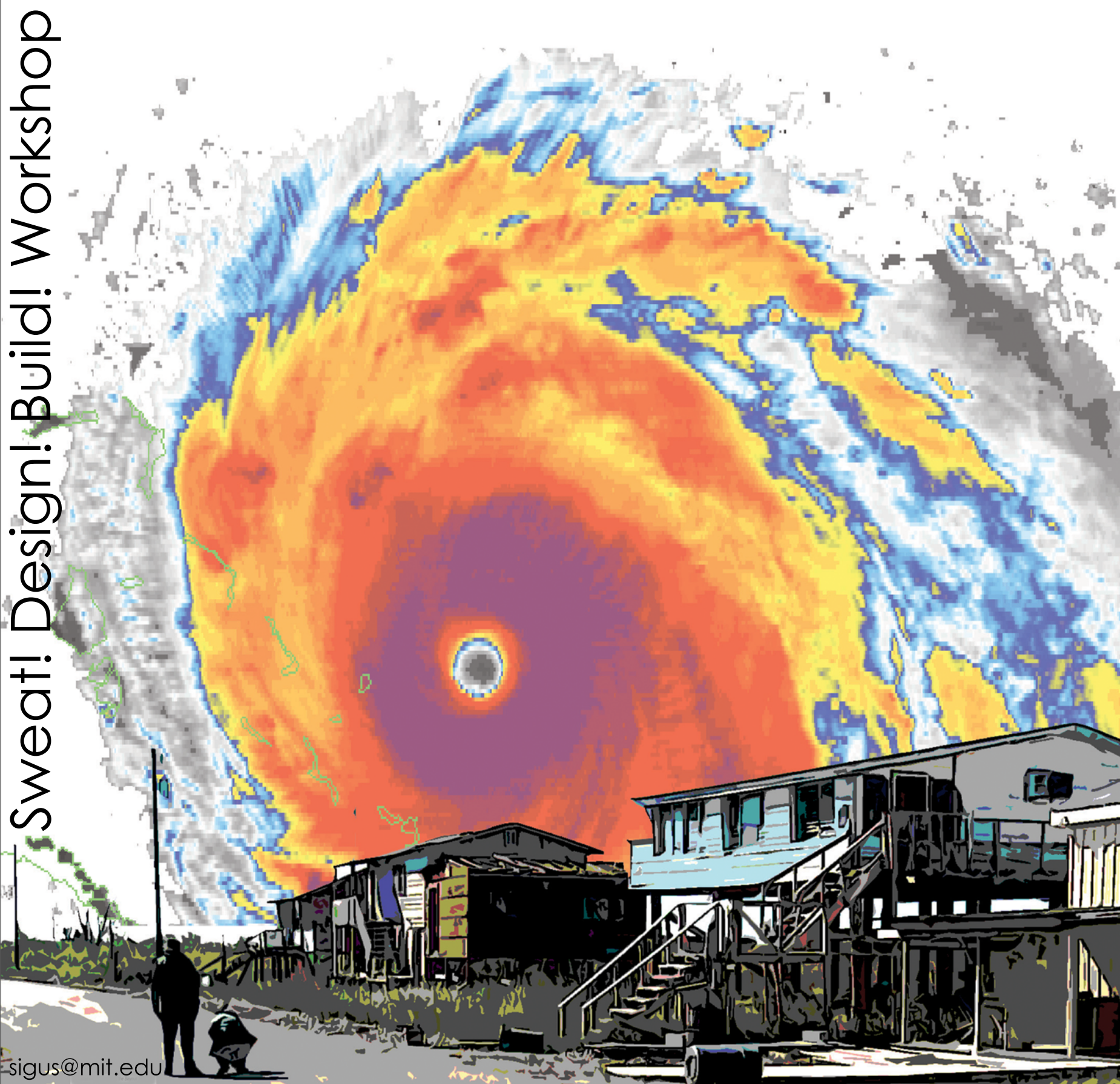


Houma, Louisiana

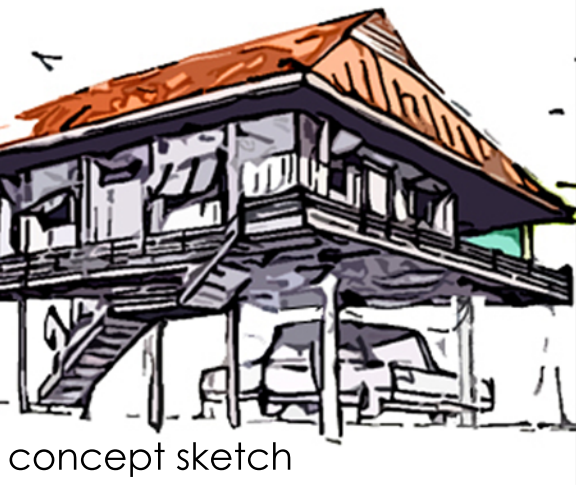

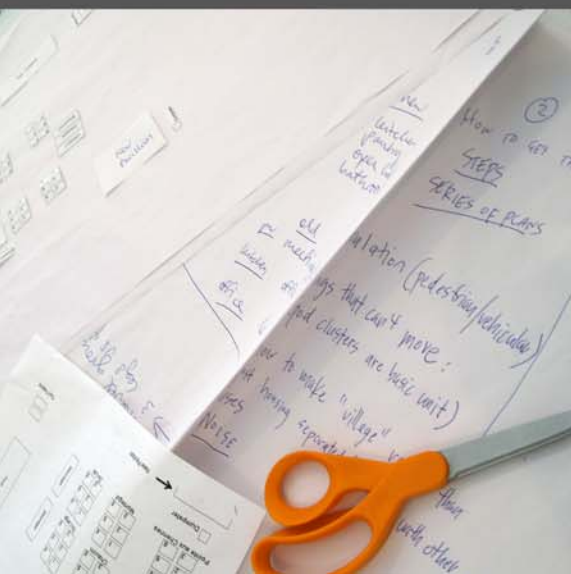

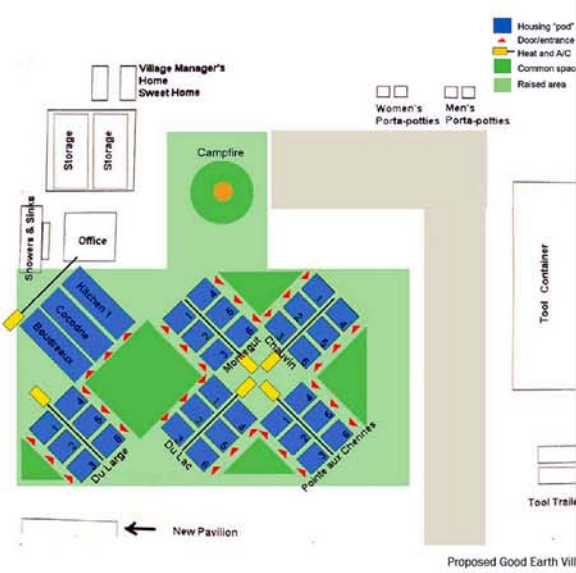
